- 1 **Acadiana Center for the Arts** 101 W. Vermilion St. | 233-7060

- 2 **Adrian Fulton's Gallery** 302 Jefferson St. | 658-3274  
Adrian Fulton is a local artist whose paintings, portraits and caricatures capture timeless emotion and expression.
- 3 **Architects + Artists** 200 Jefferson St. | 234-4166  
Exhibition space is a contemporary, urban gallery with work by local, regional and national artists, and once a year shows projects by UL Lafayette architecture students. Shows vary in subject matter and media.
- 4 **Cajun Spice** 535 Jefferson St. | 232-3061  
Features arts, crafts, & silk-screens de Louisiane. Metal art, jewelry, stained glass, beadwork, hand painted clocks and more abound. Original screen-printed shirt designs, indigenous to Lafayette and its Cajun joie de vivre available. Each visit promises something new.
- 5 **Cité des Arts** 109 Vine St. | 291-1122  
A non-profit, multi-use arts facility featuring classes and performance space for theater, music, dance, French studies and independent film, the center also is used as an exhibit space for visual arts. [Citedesarts.com](http://Citedesarts.com)
- 6 **Francis Pavy Gallery** 210 Gordon St. | 232-6682

The fine arts gallery within Jefferson Street Market features a different regional, national and international artist each month.

Exhibits contemporary art by local and regional artists working in many formats including painting, drawing, photography, ceramics and sculpture.
- 10 **Gallery R** 116 E. Congress St. | 769-1530
